Hiroshi Kashiwagi will read from three of his latest books, 1:30 p.m. at the BCA Bookstore, located at 2140 Durant Avenue in Berkeley.

A native of Sacramento and a Bay Area resident since 1952, Kashiwagi is a retired librarian of the San Francisco Public Library. He is a member of the Dramatists Guild and the Screen Actors Guild.

He is also the author of "Shoe Box Plays" (2008), a collection of plays that chronicle the experiences of Japanese Americans from the hardships of the Depression of the 1930s, through the bitterness and dislocation of the internment during World War II, through the rise of Asian American consciousness and pride in the late 1960s and 1970s to today.
